



Packing List for Ordeal Candidates

Required Equipment:

- Ground cloth or tarp
- Sleeping bag
- Water bottle
- Appropriate rain/weather gear
 - As with any Scouting event, be prepared for the forecasted weather!
- Plain white short-sleeved T-shirt
 - oversized to fit over any clothing
 - You will be writing on this t-shirt with a marker
- Work clothes
 - Long sleeves and pants preferred
- Work gloves
- Full field uniform ("class A")
- Personal items
- Shower items
- Towel for showering
- Any medications needed
 - Note all medications on your health form
- BSA health form
 - Parts A and B are required
 - Bring a photocopy – do not bring your original copy. These will **not** be returned to you.
- Tent for Saturday night (see NOTE below)

Optional (but Very Helpful) Equipment:

- Sleeping pad
- Camping pillow
- Bug spray
- Backpack for carrying sleeping equipment to the sleeping site on Friday night
- Ditty bag to store extra clothing while outside Friday night (separate from the pack mentioned above)
- Hiking/work boots (tennis shoes are strongly discouraged)
- Small notebook
- Pen/pencil
- Money for purchasing OA and lodge items at the trading post (Sat. evening / Sun. morning)
- Sunscreen
- Any other items you feel you may need and are not listed

On Friday night and during the day on Saturday, you **will not** be allowed to have the following equipment. Please either leave these items at home, keep them in your ditty bag, or give them to someone in your unit to hold for you until Saturday evening:

- Watch
- Flashlight
- ANY electronic equipment
- Cell phone
- Food (unless needed for medical reasons – please let the Ordeal staff know)
- Knives

**** NOTE:** You will need a **tent** for the second night of camp. Cabins are not available. You may pair up with another Ordeal candidate or with any other OA member you know that will be there that weekend and following BSA youth protection policies.
